

ARCHITECTURE & DESIGN: IDFF returns with strong line up of speakers

Design Exhibition will showcase five presentations:

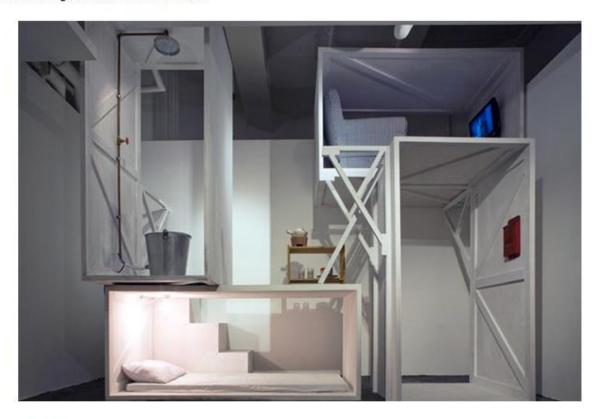
